Keeping it short so we can get to the budget meeting

- I am looking for 2 volunteers for the policy review this year. This would be something we'd have completed by the June Business Meeting for review by the Officers/Populace. **[Note: No longer need volunteers]**
- As you know, we need yearly inventories for all of the equipment/goods that are being stored by people in their homes. Due to my being made aware of some legal issues with how we do



this now, there will be some changes in how we handle things like the Gold and Iron Keys as well as the Larder. Not only will people need to submit a yearly inventory, but we will need to have a signed agreement if you're storing Baronial goods in your home.

The issue is that the law states that, without a written agreement, after a certain period, anything stored in someone's private home can be claimed as their property. We need to pay attention to this not because I think that anyone would suddenly claim Baronial property as their own, but since we've had some recent instances of people passing suddenly and the family not understanding how SCA stuff works. I don't want to end up having to replace Baronial items because we didn't cover our liability. I'm looking at this as an opportunity – we've talked about taking pictures of everything that we own and making those available on our website and this is an appropriate time for that. I'll be looking for volunteers to do this (and volunteering to help). This will make some things (like those yearly inventories) much easier.

As soon as I have the details on what that agreement needs to contain, I will share that with everyone.

Knight Marshal	<p>I haven't quite made my mind about when we're moving to the outdoor site. It's looking bad for this weekend, it's a pond right now. Even if it's warm, we probably couldn't use it. Other than that, fight practice continues.</p> <p>Gesa – Practice will start on Friday and go until Black Friday.
