4. Save the Date – Agincourt XIII

The autocrats are seeking a cheaper site and need some additional time. The save-the-date is set for Saturday 26 October 2019.

5. Letters of Intent – Webminister

Only one letter received, from the current Webminister. Kameshima was re-affirmed for two more years.

6. Business Meeting

The passed budget is below. The most significant amount is for replacing the Baronial Trailer at Cooper's Lake. We are hoping to come in under the \$5000 allocated as this is the cost of a brand-new trailer meeting the new standards. We will also now be required to carry independent insurance on the trailer going forward.

The budget was cut by nearly \$1200 between publication to the Officer's List and the meeting as people made cuts to their requests to help reduce the budget as there were some significant costs that were unavoidable – like the trailer and maintenance to the Coronets. The remaining costs kept as low as possible, but we are still looking at over \$8000 in expenditures (\$5000 of which is for the trailer).

From the Seneschal:

We are looking at some difficulty down the line as we are not able to recoup the money needed for our budget as easily as we have in the past. With the increased number of events on the calendar and increasing event costs, attendance overall is down. We are also not accepting the reality of rising site and





food prices and raising our event fees to reflect these very real costs. Added to a dearth in fundraising, this is not sustainable.

Most importantly, we need to change how we review event bids. Currently, the policy is to submit event bids at the Business Meeting and be reviewed / accepted / not accepted the same day. Since more time is needed, a variety of options were discussed, but my preference is changing the policy to give officers more time to review bids to ensure that they are viable and, if not, return them for changes or rejecting the bid if no other options are workable. Additionally, to ensure success, event bids should not be submitted less than six months before the event. Allowing this has led to some of the issues with profitability since people don't have it on their radar and with the Kingdom calendar being so full, people just aren't choosing to attend an additional even that they hadn't already planned for. This, in addition to a greater focus on advertising events, should go a long way towards getting things heading in the right direction.

Odriana will be writing up an article to talk about how events are priced and the kind of value we are delivering, even if prices are raised to reflect true costs.
